Flying home from China at 33,000 feet, the Lord put a chapter of the Bible on my heart. As I read and prayed about what it meant, God showed me over the next few months that I should concentrate on training leaders for His work in third-world countries.

Calls for leadership training were coming more frequently than I could ever meet while holding a traditional ministry position in the US. God had a wonderful plan for me to put together a team of "experts" to answer re-

quests for training.

Confirmation came as I saw God putting everything into place. Some friends had started a non-profit organization called Partners in Development Worldwide (PIDW) and asked me to be the Executive Director. I was able to transition from my jobs with IABC and API into this full-time job this past summer.

One of PIDW's ministries is the Training Center, which is my specific ministry in order to do the work God has put on my heart.
